- 28 "Come to me, all you who are struggling hard and carrying heavy loads, and I will give you rest.
- 29 Put on my yoke, and learn from me. I'm gentle and humble. And you will find rest for yourselves.
- 30 My yoke is easy to bear, and my burden is light."

John 1:35-39,43

- 35 The next day John was standing again with two of his disciples. ³⁶ When he saw Jesus walking along he said, "Look! The Lamb of God!" ³⁷ The two disciples heard what he said, and they followed Jesus.
- 38 When Jesus turned and saw them following, he asked, "What are you looking for?" They said, "Rabbi (which is translated *Teacher*), where are you staying?"
